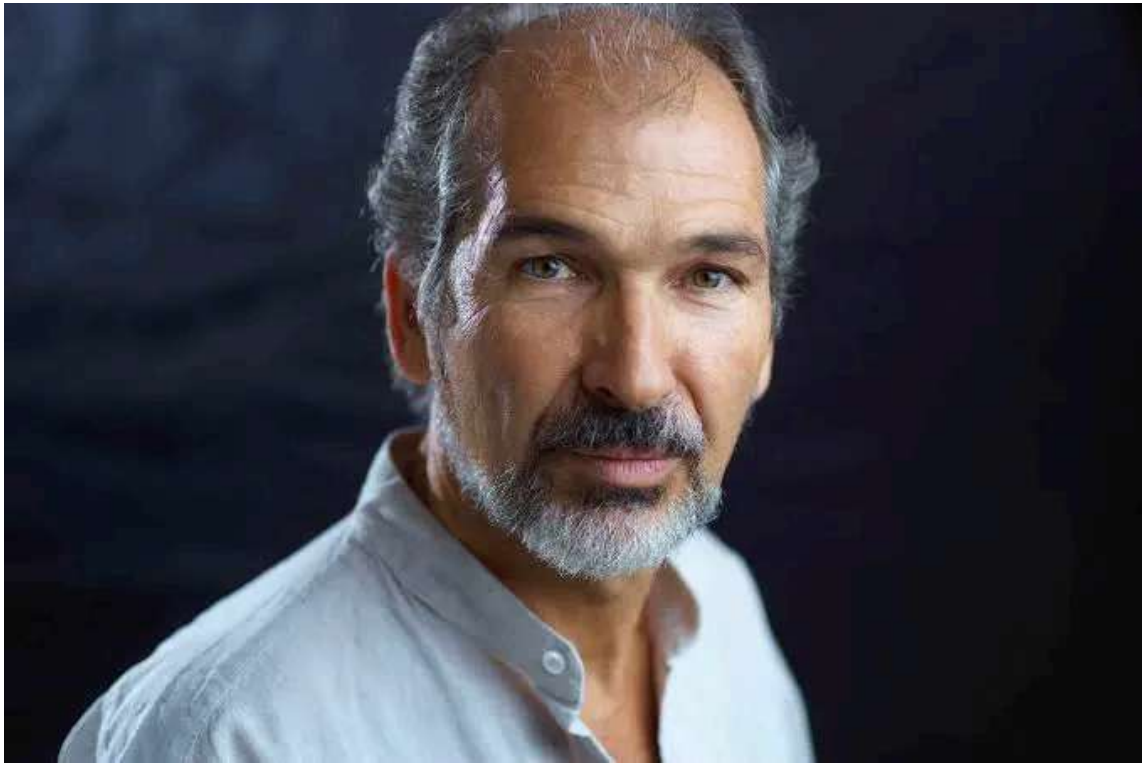




Group Facilitation with Svagito Liebermeister (www.family-constellation.net)

26th of september - 1st of october 2027, The Netherlands

Venue: The Place To Be, Zelhem - www.theplacetobe.nl (2-3 hrs in total by public transport from several airports in The Netherlands and Düsseldorf, Germany)

Language: English

Costs: €1.450 for the 4,5 day training, 5 nights, based on a 2-person room with its own shower and toilet. Including meals.

Course information

This training is an invitation for all those who are working with groups in the field of personal growth and therapy, and who feel the longing to deepen their understanding of the subtle dynamics that unfold within a group.

It is a unique chance, because Svagito doesn't offer this course so often... And it's also been years since he was in The Netherlands.

In this course, together, we will explore how to create a space of trust, presence, and love - an atmosphere in which each participant feels safe to open, to be seen, and to reveal their inner world. We will also tune in to the quality of meditative presence, allowing the group field itself to become a doorway to awareness.

You will be introduced to the art of holding and guiding open sharings in a way that supports people in moving more deeply into themselves, into silence, and into authenticity.

Among the themes we will explore:

- What allows a group process to deepen and become transformative
- Meeting 'negativity' or 'disturbances' with awareness and compassion
- The natural rhythm and stages of a group journey
- Sensitivity to different kinds of participants, and how to include everyone
- The dance between structure and openness
- What nourishes or weakens the energy of the group leader
- Recognizing personal qualities and unconscious blind spots
- The art of co-leading
- Working with participants from different cultural backgrounds

This training is primarily experiential. There will be space for participants to lead short group processes and receive conscious, supportive feedback.

Our approach is rooted in the vision of Osho - that a true therapist is not only a skilled guide, but also a fellow traveler; not separate from the group, but part of its living energy.

A short interview is required as this is a course for those who have experience working with people.

Indicative daily schedule

7.00 - 8.00 morning meditation

8.00 - 9.30 breakfast

09.45 - 9.45 session

13.00 - 14.15 lunch break

14.15 - 18.30 session

18.30 - 19.30 afternoon meditation

19.30 - 21.00 dinner break

21.00 - 22.00 evening chill activity (watching discourse, group connection, etc.)

About Svagito

Svagito Liebermeister is a psychotherapist and spiritual teacher who has been a disciple of the enlightened mystic Osho since 1980. In his courses and training groups he combines Western therapy methods with Eastern methods of meditation. He is known for his clarity and heartfulness in teaching and supporting people in their personal growth. He has been working with people therapeutically since 1981, while continuously studying a wide range of therapeutic methods including Deep Tissue Bodywork, Neo-Reichian Breathwork, Psychic Massage and Male-Female Energywork, Counseling and Trauma Therapy (SE). Since 2000 he leads his own training programs in this fascinating approach to therapy. He has trained hundreds of practitioners worldwide in the art of working with people from a space of meditation and lovingness. For many years he co-ordinated the two-month Osho Therapist Training Program at the Osho International Meditation Resort in Pune, India, one of the largest personal growth centers in the world. Every year, he travels extensively throughout Europe, Asia, Central and South America, offering courses and training programs in over 15 different countries. Svagito has published three books, which have been translated into 9 languages.

Practicalities

Maximum group size

There is room for 35 participants, apart from Svagito and assistants.

Room options

You can choose one of the following options (first come, first serve):

Cancellation policy

You will be refunded:

- until 10 weeks before the course starts: the amount you paid minus €350;
- between 10 and 2 weeks before the course starts: the amount you paid minus €700;
- during the 2 weeks before the course starts or if you leave during the course: no amount.

Sheets and towels

Sheets and towels are included. You need to prepare the bed linen yourself and take them off the last morning. You can also let the venue do this instead for €7.

Note: bring a sauna towel for an eventual sauna night.

Arrival day (26th of September or alternatively 25th)

You are welcome to arrive on the 25th at any time at the venue. There will be dinner served at 19.00. There might be possibility for lunch as well (check with Roel).

At 20.00 there will be a check-in / information meeting.

You have the option to arrive one night earlier (the 25th of September). The costs are €65 for the room and €60 for three meals.

Departure day (1st of Oct)

We will end with lunch. We need to leave the venue at 14.00 latest.

Sickness

If you feel sick, like having a flu, please inform us. We don't want to have it spread in the group.

Travel information

The address of the venue is: Brunsveldweg 9, Zelhem.

If you come from abroad and use public transport, you can fly to any airport in The Netherlands or to Düsseldorf (check Skyscanner).or take the train all the way.

If you fly to Schiphol Airport (Amsterdam), you take the train towards Arnhem/Nijmegen at the airport. You change trains in Arnhem to the local train towards Doetinchem or Winterswijk. The station of arrival is Doetinchem, where you will be picked up. There are several connections per hour.

At other Dutch airports (Rotterdam-The Hague, Eindhoven, Maastricht, Groningen) you need to take a shuttle bus to the train station first and then take the train to Arnhem. There, you also change trains to the local train towards Doetinchem or Winterswijk and get off at Doetinchem station, where you will be picked up.

It is also possible to fly to Düsseldorf in Germany. Easiest is to take train 'RE19' from the airport and exit at Zevenaar station. There you take the local train towards Doetinchem or Winterswijk and exit the train at Doetinchem station, where you will be picked up. This connection is offered every hour. There is also an ICE-option, but then you need to change trains one more time.

Information about railway services:
